

# **GIS-IDEAS 2014 AWARDS**

Based on the recommendation of panel of experts, GIS-IDEAS 2014 awards will be presented in the categories as indicated below. Each recipient of the award shall receive a certificate and a special gift.

## **1. Best Presentation Award for students and young researchers**

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- The scientific content of the paper being presented (i.e. originality, significance, etc.)
- The quality of the presentation (i.e. clarity, layout & design, etc.)
- The presentation itself (i.e. how well the speaker was able to deliver a stimulating talk, abidance to allocated time, and effectiveness of the communication of the concept to the audience, etc.)
- Full papers must be submitted.
- The student or young researcher must be the single author or first author of the submitted paper.
- The paper must be unpublished and not yet approved for publication

## **2. Best Poster Award for students and young researchers**

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Full papers must be submitted.
- Poster must have been exhibited during the poster sessions.
- The student or young researcher must be the single author or first author of the submitted paper.
- Quality of poster submission:
  1. Presentation: layout (attractiveness, legibility, creativity)
  2. Content: innovative ideas and value of subject matter
  3. Presenter's ability to effectively convey the research results
- The paper must be unpublished and not yet approved for publication
